Voting members include those persons who fall into one or more of the following categories: (a) members of its Board of Directors; (b) one coach from each of its recreational teams (c) one coach and one team manager from each of its competitive teams; and (d) one committee chair from the standing committees of the Association (Steering, Program Development, Discipline and Nomination committees) (see section 2.1(a) of bylaws). Candidates must be at least eighteen years old and be otherwise eligible as defined by the Association’s bylaws.

At the 2020 Annual General Meeting of the Douglas County Soccer Association d/b/a Real Colorado to be held in late August, we will be filling four (4) Board member positions with two year cycles Association’s thirteen member Board of Directors.

The Douglas County Soccer Association/Real Colorado Board of Directors meets the first Tuesday of every month, unless special circumstances require a rescheduling in a given month. Board members are expected to actively participate in the activities of the Association, including giving of their time to Committee assignments, giving of their resources individually and in advancing fundraising activities. The Board sets high expectations as it endeavors to build excellence in the Association and new Board members will be expected to continue this tradition of leadership.
