REGISTRATION FAQ's

What documents are required for online check-in for the 2021 RCC?

- Official team roster, approved/signed by state organization or GotSport roster as generated by your club in your GotSport account
- Pdf of all player/coach passes – Must be in alpha order of team players, coaches. Guest players, assistant coaches can be on one separate sheet/pdf.
- Travel Papers for USYS teams **coming from outside Region IV, USYS.**
- Signed RCC Team Info and Acknowledgement Form
- **DO NOT upload medical releases or RCC Covid Form**

Can I email my documents?

No. All documents must be uploaded to your GotSoccer Application (NOT GotSport) account.

Can I ask a specific question during this process?

Yes. From your documents page in your team account, RCC Event application, there is a “Notify Registrar” spot. Click on notify, type in your short question and “Add”. RCC staff can see there is a notification and will reply at the same spot. Your team contact/manager will receive an automated email when we answer.

Once I've checked in using GotSoccer, will I receive an email confirming that my roster has been approved?

Yes. All teams will receive an email confirming their roster/documents have been approved. Your actual RCC verified roster will be uploaded into your team account by us.

- Before you come to the RCC, you will print copies of your RCC verified tournament roster (enough for each scheduled game, including finals, plus extras) to bring to the tournament.
- One copy of your verified roster must be given to the referee a minimum of 15 mins. prior to each game.
- You must **always** have a hard copy of your RCC verified roster, actual laminated player/coach passes (or pdf of all passes available on your cell phone, if you do not have laminated passes) and medical forms at each game. (In an emergency, a pdf of your roster showing the RCC verification, a pdf of your passes can be shown, as long as RCC verification is clearly legible and visible).
- The referee will NOT return your roster at the end of a game. This is why you will need MANY copies at the RCC fields.

NOTE: If you do not receive your verified RCC, by the **Friday BEFORE (1 week out)** the start of the RCC pls ensure that you have no notifications in your Documents tab alerting you to any issues. Otherwise, contact us at realcup@realcolorado.net

Players not attending the event:

If a player is not attending the event, do I leave their name on the roster?

No, if a player is not attending the event; you need to cross their name off on the your official roster before you scan, upload and submit it. If, after you receive an approved roster, a Player isn't participating, you may simply cross them out on all of your paperwork without re-uploading a new roster.

Guest Players:

What is the maximum number of guest players a team can bring to the event?

Six (6) guest players will be allowed.

- Teams may roster up to the maximum permitted for their age per Real Cup rules.
- 16 for 9v9, 18 for 11v11 play through U14, 22 for U15-19 teams (18 eligible per game)
- Guest players are included in that maximum number.

How do I add a guest player?

Step 1: Obtain the guest player's current player pass/card (or pdf picture for uploading for online check-in) and medical release form.

Step 2: Copy your original roster. Please handwrite legibly and carefully, the guest player's full name, unique jersey number, player identification number and birthdate below the bottom of the existing rostered players. *** Same process for assistant coaches or coaches NOT appearing on the official roster, including providing coach pass upload.

Step 3: Proper paperwork for guest players is required:

US CLUB TEAMS DO NOT NEED ANY EXTRA PAPERWORK – just their US CLUB ROSTERS with the guest players written in, US Club player cards/passes, medical waivers.

USYS TEAMS USING GUEST PLAYERS:

- A guest player is any player not listed on your official roster you are using in the RCC. Some clubs or state associations will add guest players to a traveling team's official roster. **Please ask your club or state registrar about this!** Any player listed/typed on your official, signed, verified roster is not considered a guest player by RCC.
- All guest players (written in by you on your roster) must have their player pass included with the whole team's passes for RCC approval and their medical release at the field with those of the entire team.

IMPORTANT NOTE: US Club Soccer teams may only take guest players registered under US Club Soccer, and USYS teams may only take guest players registered under USYS. Same for AYSO and USSSA teams. No roster may be comprised of players with different passes from different organizations (no "mixed rosters").
